

## Computer code guide

When including computer code, please consistently use a clearly distinguishable, monospaced font to indicate this such as Courier New or Lucida Console.

This can be done in line for short extracts such as functions or objects, for example

```
<html> or library().
```

Longer extracts should be presented as a block, for example:

```
<html>
<body>
<p>Example</p>
<p>Code</p>
</body>
</html>
```

Consider the reader and how best to present examples so they can clearly be understood and copied, especially when accessing the book electronically, for example distinguishing between the input code itself and the output within the coding environment.

Please also supply a PDF of any chapters containing code. This is particularly important if the code contains any spacing or indentation so the typesetter has a reference for how it should appear in the book.
